

Updated eLearning Days Plan 2025-2026

This school is designated as an eLearning School. Those schools who meet the criteria for an eLearning School as determined by the Department of Education may use up to five eLearning days to allow for the make-up of short-term disruptions to in-person teaching and learning.

Expectations

In the event of an eLearning day, an announcement will be made using your student's PowerSchool contact information. Families will receive an email, phone call, and a text. In addition, all information will be posted to our social media sites.

To receive attendance credit for an eLearning day, students should:

- Check their school email for information from their teachers for each course
- Log on to Google Classroom and visit the page for each of their courses. This is where the instructions and assignment for the eLearning day will be posted. Students use Google Classroom daily in their courses and are familiar with this procedure.
- Students should complete the work assigned in each class by 11:59 pm that evening to receive credit for attendance. Each assignment is designed to not exceed more than 50 minutes worth of work per class—totaling a maximum of 200 minutes.
- All work will be digital.
- All classroom teachers will be available during regular school hours via email, can be reached by phone, and/or can hold a Zoom meeting by request during specified office hours in the event that students or families need further assistance.

Schedule

Upon the announcement of a shift to an eLearning day, all classroom teachers will post a virtual assignment with detailed instructions to their Google Classroom page for each course. These assignments will be set with a due date of that evening by 11:59 pm.

Classroom teachers will be available for office hours from 8 am-12 pm for requested phone calls and Zoom meetings at which time they will be able to provide live assistance to students and/or families. In addition, classroom teachers will be available via email during regular school hours from 8 am-3 pm.
