



GAVIN'S LAW

In accordance with **Gavin's Law (H.3583)**, Coastal High School prohibits sexual extortion, including the use of sexually explicit images or videos to threaten, coerce, or blackmail another person. Under South Carolina law, sexual extortion is a felony offense and is an aggravated felony when the victim is a minor, vulnerable adult, or suffers bodily injury or death as a result of the crime.

The school will provide annual education and awareness regarding Gavin's Law to students, parents, and staff through presentations, electronic communications, newsletters, and information posted on the school's website. Educational materials will also be made available throughout the school year.
